



**Minutes for April's Roman Agricultural Day Meeting**

**March 28th, 2019. At 4:00 PM**, the meeting was called to order. Present were Guillermo Ariel Gleizer, Ariel Oliver Gleizer and Maximilian Damm.

**Item:** The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved as distributed.

**Item:** The first Roman Agricultural Day event. Ariel presents the idea to organize a day of activities in one of the last farms inside Rome, the Merlonghi Family Orto Vivaio. The idea is to experience Roman agricultural practices and traditions, whether in the field of arts or in the field of land. The day suggested for the event is April 27th, from 10AM to 5PM. Approved.

**Item:** The activities of the event. Guillermo presents the voluntary activities: tour of the property; help in the agricultural chores (planting, potting, etc); help in the fish ponds; practical lecture on growing and caring for vegetable and flower plants; practical lecture on cooking. The participants will also have lunch and receive a voucher for a "Goodies Bag" with vegetables from the garden to be used in the Fall. Approved.

**Item:** Ariel reminds the Board of the need for a Liberatoria [waiver], by which participants accept all responsibility and liability in case of accident or any other problem to themselves and/or their property. Approved.

**Item:** Guillermo will start negotiations with the owners of the nursery (vivaio) to use their installations and receive educational and practical support. Ariel proposes a suggested donation to cover some of the costs. Ariel will study feasibility and report. Approved.

**Item:** There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:00PM.
